WHEREAS, The City of San Diego traditionally has taken the position, and continues to do so, that relationships between itself and its employees are municipal affairs, as that term is used in Section 5 of Article XI of the California Constitution, not subject to the legislative power of the State except through Constitutional amendment; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, nevertheless, has examined the scheme for public sector labor relations proposed in Senate Bill 2133, now pending before the California Legislature, and finds it to have considerable merit; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

That, subject to the above-stated reservations concerning the status of The City of San Diego as a charter city, this Council, for and on behalf of the citizens of the City of San Diego, hereby publicly expresses its support for SB 2133,
