WHEREAS, said reconstruction will necessitate the construction and maintenance of temporary overhead telephone lines to provide telephone service during the reconstruction period; and

WHEREAS, the above-specified Embarcadero area lies within an established underground utility district; and

WHEREAS, the construction and maintenance of temporary telephone lines in the above-described area, under the aforementioned circumstances, would not be detrimental to the public health, safety and general welfare; and

WHEREAS, said construction and maintenance of temporary telephone lines would be without discrimination as to any person or utility company; and

WHEREAS, the existence of said temporary overhead facilities would exceed a 30-day period; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

That pursuant to Section 61.0510 of the San Diego
Municipal Code, the construction and maintenance of temporary
overhead telephone lines be and they are hereby authorized

Re: Temporary Aerial Telephone Lines in Connection With Reconstruction of Embarcadero Apron Wharf

In accordance with Municipal Code Section 61.0510, a permit is hereby requested to construct temporary aerial telephone lines along the Embarcadero, between Broadway Pier and the County Administration Building, as shown on the attached sketch.

The Port District expects to award a contract soon for replacement of the Emparcadero apron wharf and stabilization of the seawall. This facility, constructed about sixty years ago, has deteriorated to the extent that major reconstruction is required. As a necessary part of the work certain telephone lines that are within an underground utilities district must be temporarily located overhead. Following completion of the wharf reconstruction the telephone lines will be replaced underground.

Although the entire project will take about a year to complete, the approximate periods that temporary aerial lines will be required are as follows:

Broadway Pier to B Street Pier: September through December

1974.

Anthony's Restaurant northward: November 1974 through

March 1975.

Because our contract documents cannot be completed until after receipt of the requested permit, your early action on this matter will be appreciated.


