RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY  
OF SAN DIEGO, CALIFORNIA, ORDERING  
ABANDONMENT OF PROCEEDINGS

**JUN 13 1974**

(Amalfi Street Assessment District)

WHEREAS, in proceedings pursuant to the Municipal Improvement Act of 1913, and in full compliance with the Special Assessment, Limitation and Majority Protest Act of 1931, the Council of the City of San Diego initiated proceedings for the undergrounding of certain utility facilities in the La Jolla area of San Diego, and in pursuance thereof adopted Resolution No. 207434 on February 27, 1973, overruling protests and determining that the public interest, convenience and necessity require the improvement and determining that the project is feasible; and

WHEREAS, on May 2, 1974, the Council adopted its resolution of intention, Resolution No. 210499, declaring its intention to order said improvements; and

WHEREAS, on May 2, 1974, the Council adopted Resolution No. 210500, approving the Report prepared by the City Manager and appointing June 13, 1974, as the time for hearing thereon; and

WHEREAS, said hearing was duly held at the time so fixed at the hour of 8:30 a.m. in the Council Chambers of the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the Council finds that written protests

were made and filed against the proposed improvements, in connection with the entire proceeding and up to the time of the hearing, by owners of more than one-half of the area to be assessed for the improvements, and that said protests were not withdrawn so as to reduce the protests to less than a majority; and

WHEREAS, Section 2930 of the California Streets and Highways Code requires that proceedings shall forthwith be abandoned in the event of a written protest by the owners of a majority of the area proposed to be assessed for the improvements; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, California, as follows:

Section 1. The Council hereby orders that said proceedings shall be and the same are hereby abandoned.

Section 2. The City Clerk is authorized and directed forthwith to record a certified copy of this Resolution of Abandonment, with the County Recorder of the County of San Diego, in the form and manner as provided in Section 3117 of the Streets and Highways Code.
