

RESOLUTION No. 210916

Adopted on JUN 20 1974

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego as follows:

That fees and surcharges for the use of the municipal golf courses located in Balboa Park and Torrey Pines Park be established as follows:

Said Torrey Pines monthly ticket entitles holder to play a maximum of 18 holes of golf per day at Balboa Park or Torrey Pines Golf Courses except that said ticket shall be subject to the green fee charges listed above when used Saturdays, Sundays or Legal Holidays, and shall be further subject to reasonable rules and regulations of the golf course management.

Said Torrey Pines green fee rates specified above as "new fees" shall be charged to all golfers except those who have applied for and been issued a card signifying that they are residents of the City of San Diego or are property taxpayers in the City of San Diego. Golfers showing their registration card will be allowed golfing privileges at the rates specified above as "present" fees.

Said monthly ticket entitles holder to play a maximum of 18 holes of golf per day at the Balboa Park Golf Course, except that said ticket shall be subject to the green fee charges as listed above when used on Saturdays, Sundays and Legal Holidays, and shall be further subject to reasonable rules and regulations of the golf course management.

Said monthly ticket entitles holder to play a maximum of nine holes of golf per day at Balboa Park 9-hole golf course only, except that said ticket shall not be valid on Saturdays, Sundays or Legal Holidays.

Said Student Monthly Ticket entitles elementary, junior and senior high school students who have not yet reached their eighteenth birthdays to play a maximum of eighteen holes of golf on weekdays only, subject to rules and regulations of management on any municipal golf course. Student tickets may also be issued to members of any golf team representing collegiate level institutions located in San Diego for the competitive golf season only.

Said Balboa Park green fee rates specified above as "new fees" shall be charged to all golfers except those who have applied for and been issued a card signifying that they are residents of the City of San Diego or are property taxpayers in the City of San Diego. Golfers showing their registration card will be allowed golfing privileges at the rates specified above as "present" fees.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Park and Recreation Department is hereby authorized to select five "home" student golf teams of six members each from junior high schools, senior high schools and colleges in the City of San Diego for play at Balboa and the same number for play at Torrey Pines. Subject to scheduling by the course management, with each team member required to purchase a student monthly ticket, match contests may be arranged at both courses between such student teams and student teams of like number of members from "visiting" teams chosen from other junior and senior high schools or colleges and, further, to arrange reciprocal waiving of green fees and the reciprocal honoring of monthly student tickets with their respective "home" courses, provided that team matches shall start at the discretion of the course management, are limited to one match of two teams on any school day except Wednesday when there shall be no team matches.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Park and Recreation Department is hereby authorized to arrange for the waiving of green fees for contestants entered in the annual Junior Golf Championships held at any municipal golf course.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that for the purpose of this resolution Legal Holidays are as defined in Municipal Code Section 21.04.



BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Auditor is hereby directed to deposit the revenues accumulated from the above surcharge amounts for use of the Torrey Pines Golf Course into a special fund to be used to partially reimburse Fund 245 (Capital Outlay Fund) for the expenses necessary to renovate the greens at Torrey Pines Golf Course.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Resolution No. 205888, adopted June 20, 1973, be and the same is hereby rescinded.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this resolution shall become effective on July 1, 1974.
