WHEREAS, this Council did on March 19, 1974 by Resolution No. 210171 establish the PALM AVENUE UNDERGROUND UTILITY DISTRICT which required the conversion of certain overhead electric. communication, and community antenna television facilities; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to said Resolution No. 210171, the date upon which property in the District had to be ready to receive underground service and the date upon which the removal of all poles, overhead wires and associated overhead structures had to be effected was to be subsequently designated by resolution; and

WHEREAS, Section 61.0510 of the Municipal Code of The City of San Diego provides that the Council may grant permission in cases of unusual circumstances to any person to maintain overhead wires and associated overhead structures within the district when it will not be detrimental to the public health, safety and welfare; and

WHEREAS, an existing overhead electrical line within the existing easement located approximately 190 feet east of the east line of Lot 10, Loma Vista, Map 2349, is located on a 69 KV transmission line which will not be undergrounded and the utility company has been unable to negotiate an underground easement for the existing electrical line; and

WHEREAS, said facts constitute unusual circumstances and the continued maintenance of the existing overhead line is not detrimental to the public health, safety and general welfare; NOW, THEREFORE, MICROFILMED

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BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

- 1. That July 30, 1974 be and the same is hereby established and designated as the date upon which all property within that portion of the PALM AVENUE UNDERGROUND UTILITY DISTRICT, 16th Street to 19th Street, must be ready to receive underground service and that July 1, 1975 be and the same is hereby designated as the date upon which all overhead utility facilities must be removed.
- 2. That the utility company is hereby granted permission to maintain an overhead electrical line within the existing easement located approximately 190 feet east of the east line of Lot 10, Loma Vista, Map 2349, in the PALM AVENUE UNDERGROUND UTILITY DISTRICT. Such grant of permission shall be temporary and revocable in nature.
- 3. That Resolution No. 210171 be and the same is hereby amended to reflect the said exception granted herein.
