RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO REQUESTING THE CONSOLIDATION OF A SPECIAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD IN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO ON TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 5, 1974, WITH THE STATEWIDE GENERAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON THAT SAME DATE.


WHEREAS, this Council intends to call a special municipal election to be held on November 5, 1974, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified voters of the City six propositions as set forth in this resolution amending the Charter of The City of San Diego; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable that this special municipal election be consolidated with the Statewide General Election to be held on the same date and that within the City the election precincts, polling places, voting booths and election officials for the two elections be the same, and that the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego be authorized to canvass the returns of the special municipal election, and that the Statewide General Election and this special municipal election be held in all respects as if there were only one election; and

WHEREAS, this Council within the time required by law has or will adopt an ordinance calling for a special municipal election and consolidating it with the Statewide General Election; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

- 1. The Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego is hereby requested to consolidate a special municipal election to be held in the City of San Diego on November 5, 1974, with the Statewide General Election to be held on the same date.
- 2. The exact form of the propositions to be voted upon at the special municipal election as such propositions shall appear on the ballot is as follows:

period and, among other clarifying changes, to change certain phrases and words in the section from "Army, Navy, Marine Corps, or any division thereof" to "the United States Armed Forces," from "wife" to "spouse," from "widow" to "surviving spouse," and from "United States Veterans' Bureau" to "United States Veterans' Administration." The propositions shall be designated on the ballot by a letter printed on the left margin of the square containing the description of the measure as provided in Section 10231 of the California Elections Code.

- 3. The Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego is hereby authorized to canvass the returns of the special municipal election and is requested to conduct the elections in all respects as if there were only one election using only one form of ballot.
- 4. The Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego is requested to issue to all officers of the County charged with duties pertaining to the Statewide General Election, instructions to take any and all steps necessary for the holding of a consolidated election.
- 5. The City Clerk of The City of San Diego is hereby directed to file a certified copy of this resolution with the Board of Supervisors, County Clerk and Registrar of Voters of the County of San Diego.
