BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego as follows:

1. That the expenditure of \$100,000 is hereby authorized from Gas Tax Fund 219 of The City of San Diego solely and exclusively for the purpose of providing funds for the purchase and installation of miscellaneous traffic signs and street name signs at various locations citywide, supplementing Resolution No. 207105 in this amount; and

2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized and empowered to do by City forces the necessary work for the installation of the above designated signs, pursuant to recommendation of the City Manager and submission of estimates by him indicating that said work can be done by the City forces more economically than if let by contract.
