WHEREAS, the Suggestion Awards Committee has heretofore made certain recommendations to this Council; and

WHEREAS, the Council has reviewed said recommendations as well as the suggestions as presented; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

That the following suggestion awards are hereby approved and the Auditor and Comptroller is hereby directed to issue warrants out of the General Fund for the following suggestions:

<u>NAME</u>	<u>DEPARTMENT</u>	<u>AMOUNT</u>	<u>SUGGESTION</u>
David R. English	POLICE DEPARTMENT	\$75	Officer English proposed that the flag at the Southern Station be illuminated at night so the American flag could be left flying. This has been done for a saving of about 150 hours of an Officer's time per year putting up and taking down the flag 365 days a year. This amounts to about \$750 per year.
Alvin A. Conway	GENERAL SERVICES Equipment Division	\$70	Mr. Conway is a Machinest who designed a special tool for deburring hydraulic cylinders in a faster and safer way. Breakage of pistons and cylinders is also eliminated. A total saving of \$678 per year is estimated.
Lois C. Buzzelli	WATER UTILITIES	\$60	The use of form letters and memorandums for handling special water billings was proposed by this Intermediate Typist. This reduces the time required for a Clerk and a Hydrologist amounting to \$598 per year.
Clyde E. Elmore	ENGINEERING & DEVEL.	\$20	This Surveyor proposed an inexpensive magnetic device for locating survey points in streets that have had the steel survey points coated over. This saves \$204 worth of Survey Crew time per year.
J. Anthony Dickens	GENERAL SERVICES Equipment Division	\$10	Equipment Mechanic Dickens suggested that lubrication records be kept on heavy equipment at landfill sites for better control of the lubrication schedule. This has been done, but it is not practical to estimate savings. Some saving in lubrication time should be made.
