WHEREAS, it is in the public interest that said exchange be made, and the City Manager, pursuant to Section 22.0902.2 of the San Diego Municipal Code, has recommended it; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

That the Mayor and the City Clerk of said City be, and they are hereby authorized and empowered to execute, for and on behalf of, and as the act and deed of, The City of San Diego, a quitclaim

deed, the form of which is on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. 748595, quitclaiming to AVCO COMMUNITY DEVELOPERS, INC., an existing easement for drainage purposes affecting a portion of Rancho San Bernardo, as more particularly described in said form of quitclaim deed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Clerk of said City be, and he is hereby authorized and directed to deliver said deed and a certified copy of this resolution to the Property Director of said City for further handling.
