WHEREAS, The City of San Diego was granted and has operated this past year under a multi-jurisdictional grant entitled "Strike Force-Robbery" pursuant to the provisions of the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968; and

WHEREAS, said grant was for a one-year period ending October 30, 1974; and

WHEREAS, the City has been informed by the Office of Criminal Justice Planning (OCJP) that funds are available for a second year renewal of said program; and

WHEREAS, City desires to continue said program; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

That the City Manager be and he is hereby authorized to submit a grant application to OCJP for a second year Police Department "Strike Force-Robbery" grant pursuant to the terms and conditions set forth in the form of grant application on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. 748649.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Manager be and he is hereby authorized to execute said grant contract when awarded including any amendments and extensions thereof.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Manager be and he is hereby authorized to execute necessary agreements for services of a Project Analyst and Research Assistant/Typist on or after the effective date of the grant contract, the terms and

conditions of said service contracts to be as set forth in the form of agreements on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document Nos. 748650 and 748651, respectively.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Manager be and he is hereby authorized to initiate and execute a joint powers agreement between all member agencies involved in the grant pursuant to the terms and conditions set forth in the form of joint powers agreement on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. 748652 to provide for multi-jurisdictional police powers for project personnel.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that The City of San Diego agrees to provide those matching funds for the "Strike Force-Robbery" project delineated in said agreement.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that none of the grant funds received hereunder shall be used to supplant on-going law enforcement expenditures.
