WHEREAS, the San Diego City Council should take a position on this matter and direct its delegate to the Comprehensive Planning Organization in this regard; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that The City of San Diego communicate to the Department of Defense the desire of The City of San Diego to share Miramar Naval Air Station as a joint military-civil airport at such time as the Department of Defense concurs in that use.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City of San Diego's delegate to the Comprehensive Planning Organization ("CPO") be, and he is hereby instructed to call for a weighted vote in connection with any vote on the location of a regional airport and vote said weighted vote in accordance with this resolution.
