WHEREAS, the Act contains provision for computation of hours worked for purposes of calculating payment of overtime compensation; and

WHEREAS, the provisions of the Act have been incorporated in the annual salary ordinance adopted by this Council; and

WHEREAS, the provisions so set forth in the Act and incorporated in the salary ordinance are in conflict with the provisions of Council Policy No. 300-2, dated July 24, 1962, relating to the same subject; and

WHEREAS, all other pertinent provisions of Council Policy
No. 300-2 are also set forth in the annual salary ordinance; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Council to rectify such conflict resulting from the application of the Act to The City of San Diego; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that Resolution No. 171895 dated July 24, 1962, which adopted Council Policy No. 300-2, be and the same is hereby rescinded.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Clerk is hereby instructed to delete the aforesaid from the Council Policy Manual.
