

RESOLUTION NO. 211774

WHEREAS, the continuing relocation of County of San Diego offices and functions from the central downtown area of the City to suburban locations contributes to the diminution of the principal objectives of the Progress Guide and General Plan of the City of San Diego which includes the maintenance of a strong central core; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors on March 26, 1974, adopted Board Policy No. 27 which states:

It is incumbent on the County to be guided in its own real estate projects by the same standards it would seek from the private sector. The leadership role of the County as regional government dictates that it place its proprietary real estate developments in a manner to stimulate desirable neighborhood redevelopment and/or to assist in the implementation of master-planned land use patterns.

Occupancy costs are but one basis for comparing alternative locations. Stimulating appropriate land use development is of equal significance. Staff recommended sites in furtherance of capital projects planning implementation shall identify and analyze land use factors and recommend between alternate locations in consideration of such an analysis.

WHEREAS, concerted commitment from every level of government is vital to assure the continuing function of Centre City as the administrative, financial, cultural, entertainment core and transportation focus of the metropolitan area.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego that the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego is hereby requested to give strong consideration to our mutual efforts to strengthen the heart of the City and to do everything possible to maintain and return County functions within the central core.
