BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego as follows:

That the City Manager be and he is hereby authorized and empowered to execute, for and on behalf of said City, an agreement with the SAN DIEGO JUNIOR CHAMBER OF COMMERCE, a nonprofit California corporation, to sponsor, manage and supervise the entry and construction of a float in the annual Tournament of Roses Parade on January 1, 1975, and to administer the allocation of funds granted the Junior Chamber by the City of San Diego for the marching band representing the City and County of San Diego in that Rose Parade, under the terms and conditions set forth in the form of agreement on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. 749052.

That the expenditure of \$12,000.00 from Transient Occupancy Tax Fund 223 is hereby approved solely and exclusively to provide funds for the services stated above.
