BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego,
as follows:

1. That The City of San Diego, operating through its Engineering and Development Department under the direction of the City Manager, hereby assumes full responsibility for the implementation and operation of the Neighborhood Development Program of the San Diego Model Cities Program in accordance with the Grant Agreement between the City and the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), along with appurtenant regulations and in accordance with the terms and conditions as they may apply as set forth in the City Supplemental General Conditions (Document No. 738535), Labor Standards, and HUD Regulations (Document No. 738532) on file in the office of the City Clerk.


2. The operation of the Neighborhood Development Program and costs incurred thereto shall be no more liberal than policies, procedures and practices applied uniformly to both federally assisted and other activities of the City.

3. The City shall operate said project, in a manner consistent with the Project Scope of Services, attached hereto as Exhibit A; Project Work Program, attached hereto as Exhibit B; and the itemized Program Budget, attached hereto as Exhibit C; provided, however, that if said Project is not being reasonably maintained in accordance with its work schedule and budget

expenditures, the City Manager shall be and he is hereby authorized to initiate appropriate revisions to the Model Cities Department's budget in line with actual budget expenditures either by deletion or addition, thereby minimizing the amount of unexpended Program funds remaining at the end of the Transition Period.

4. That the City Auditor and Comptroller be, and he is hereby authorized to transfer the sum of \$102,000 from Model Cities transition period Fund No. 2904 of The City of San Diego to Fund No. 2672 of the Engineering and Development Department of said City to be used by said Department and accounted for separately, solely and exclusively, for the purpose of providing funds for the operation of the above-described project. Said funds shall not be transferred except upon approval of the project set forth hereinabove by the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development. Said approval by the Department of Housing and Urban Development shall be evidenced in writing and said funds shall not be transferred except upon satisfaction of the City Auditor and Comptroller that said funds are approved and available.

SCOPE OF SERVICES

General Purpose

This project will match a \$174,300 HUD Grant on the usual sharing formula. The NDP funds are to be used for "implementation planning" and to prepare precise redevelopment plans for the Wabash Corridor, Harbor 101 area and the San Ysidro business district.

The criteria for selection of the new NDP areas is based on areas with the largest concentration of housing and environmental deficiencies.
