AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER II, ARTICLE 2,
DIVISION 23, OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE
BY AMENDING SECTION 22.2302 RELATING TO THE
DEPARTMENT OF LEGISLATIVE ANALYST.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego,
as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter II, Article 2, Division 23, of
the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended
by amending Section 22.2302 to read as follows:

SEC. 22.2302 POWERS AND DUTIES OF LEGISLATIVE ANALYST

The Legislative Analyst shall assist the City Council
on any matters coming before it for legislative considera-
tion and decision by providing, developing and analyzing
information on said matters.

The Department of Legislative Analyst is not an admin-
istrative department. The powers and duties of the
Legislative Analyst shall include, but not be limited to,
the following:

- (1) Gathering, organizing, and analyzing data
and information relative to matters requiring legis-
lative action, such as transportation, mass transit,
C.P.O. and regional governmental organization, land
use development and programs, and municipal expendi-
tures and revenues.

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(2) Providing a formal, comprehensive annual budgetary analysis, including an in-depth program analysis prior to Council action as set forth in Section 71 of the City Charter.

(3) Providing comparative studies of other cities as they relate to municipal operations.

(4) Providing comparative analysis of the impact and feasibility of various programs and suggestions presented to the Council for legislative action.

(5) Performing related work as directed by the Council.

In accordance with the City Charter provisions granting exclusive administrative responsibility to the City Manager, neither the Legislative Analyst nor the Department of Legislative Analyst shall have any responsibility whatsoever for the administration of City business. The sole purpose of the Department of Legislative Analyst shall be to provide analytical assistance to the City Council for its legislative deliberations.

The Charter prohibition against Councilmanic interference in the administration of City government shall be understood to extend to the Legislative Analyst and the Department of Legislative Analyst; provided, however, the prohibition against interference in the administration shall not prevent Council-authorized contact by personnel of the Department of Legislative Analyst with the City Manager, or


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with members of his staff, for the purpose of obtaining information to be provided by the Department to the Council to assist the Council in the making of legislative decisions.

The Department of Legislative Analyst, through its Director, shall report to the Council its activities, in writing, quarterly at the scheduled Council meeting the first week of each quarter of the calendar year, or more often as the Council may hereafter direct.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.



- (4) Providing comparative analysis of the impact and feasibility of various programs and suggestions presented to the Council for legislative action.
- (5) Performing related work as directed by the Council.

In accordance with the City Charter provisions granting exclusive administrative responsibility to the City Manager, neither the Legislative Analyst nor the Department of Legislative Analyst shall have any responsibility whatsoever for the administration of City business. The sole purpose of the Department of Legislative Analyst shall be to provide analytical assistance to the City Council for its legislative deliberations.
