AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 11348 (NEW SERIES), AS AMENDED, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1974-75 AND APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY MONEY TO OPERATE THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR," BY AMENDING SECTION 2, SUBSECTION 12 THEREOF RELATING TO APPROPRIATION OF EXCESS ESTIMATED REVENUES IN THE STADIUM OPERATIONS FUND.

WHEREAS, the monies appropriated for expenditure in Operations Fund (256) are predicated on estimated parking and concession revenues; and

WHEREAS, due to the unprecedented 1974 baseball season attendance, actual concession and parking revenues received exceeded the budgeted allocations; and

WHEREAS, actual expenses are in direct correlation to actual attendance and consequently exceeded that estimated in the appropriations ordinance; and

WHEREAS, it is now necessary to provide that the excess revenues may be properly allocated for expenditure to corresponding contractual commitments; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 11348 (New Series), as amended, entitled "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1974-75 AND APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY MONEY TO OPERATE THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR," be and the same is hereby amended by amending Section 2,
