AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 11348 (NEW SERIES), AS AMENDED, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1974-75 AND APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY MONEY TO OPERATE THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR" BY ESTABLISHING CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS PROGRAM #38-020 ENTITLED "ADDITION TO VETERANS SECTION II IN DIVISION 11" AND TRANSFERRING THE NECESSARY MONIES WITHIN THE CAPITAL OUTLAY FUND 245.

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 211415 the Council authorized a special group sales agreement with Chinese Consolidated Benevolent Association for the purchase of lots in Mt. Hope Cemetery; and

WHEREAS, at that time it was noted that the area would have to be improved at an estimated cost of \$7,500 and that the CIP program would have to be supplemented; and

WHEREAS, the current estimate of improvements is \$9,000; and

WHEREAS, it is now necessary to transfer funds within Capital Outlay Fund 245 to provide monies for said improvements; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 11348 (New Series), as amended, entitled "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1974-75 AND APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY MONEY TO OPERATE THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR," be and the same is hereby

amended to amend that portion relating to the Capital Improvements Program by transferring the sum of \$10,000.00 from the Capital Outlay Fund (245) Reserve to the Addition to Veterans Section II in Division 11 Fund, hereby established and identified as Capital Improvements Program #38-020.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.


