

EMERGENCY ORDINANCE NO. 11621

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER VIII, ARTICLE 4, SECTION 84.12 OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE RELATING TO THE USE OF SKATEBOARDS, COASTERS, ROLLER SKATES, AND SIMILAR DEVICES RESTRICTED.

WHEREAS, in anticipation that an ordinance prohibiting use of skateboards, coasters, roller skates, and similar devices in the city-owned parkade at 1st and A Streets in The City of San Diego will be effective in 30 days, persons, particularly youngsters and teenagers, have been flooding the parkade even at times when it is heavily used by automobiles; and

WHEREAS, such increased skateboard activity has created an immediate danger to life and safety of the persons, teenagers and youths using skateboards, as well as others using the parkade for the purpose of automobile parking; and

WHEREAS, the Council should take immediate steps to protect the safety and very life of these persons, teenagers and youths using skateboards in the parkade completely disregarding their own safety and lives as well as that of others using the parkade for the purpose of automobile parking; and

WHEREAS, there appears to be no other means to control this dangerous activity except by the adoption of an emergency ordinance causing the aforesaid ordinance to be immediately effective as an emergency measure; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego,
as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter VIII, Article 4, Section 84.12 of
the San Diego Municipal Code be amended to read as follows:

SEC. 84.12 USE OF SKATEBOARDS, COASTERS, ROLLER
SKATES, AND SIMILAR DEVICES RESTRICTED

It shall be unlawful for any person upon roller
skates or riding on or by means of a coaster, skateboard,
toy vehicle, or similar device to go upon an open roadway
in the City of San Diego, or upon the sidewalk or public
plaza in any business district, or upon the inclined ramp
or other inclined surface area of any city-owned or privately
owned parkade where signs forbidding such activity are displayed
at the ground level elevator entrance and at each vehicular
entrance to the parkade.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force
immediately on the day of its adoption pursuant to Section 17 of
the Charter.

WHEREAS, there appears to be no other means to control this dangerous activity except by the adoption of an emergency ordinance causing the aforesaid ordinance to be immediately effective as an emergency measure; NOW,

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter VIII, Article 4, Section 84.12 of the San Diego Municipal Code be amended to read as follows:

SEC. 84.12 USE OF SKATEBOARDS, COASTERS, ROLLER SKATES, AND SIMILAR DEVICES RESTRICTED.

It shall be unlawful for any person upon roller skates or riding on or by means of a coaster, skateboard, toy vehicle, or similar device to go upon an open roadway in the City of San Diego, or upon the sidewalk or public plaza in any business district, or upon the inclined ramp or other inclined surface area of any city-owned or privately owned parkade where signs forbidding such activity are displayed at the ground level elevator entrance and at each vehicular entrance to the parkade.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately on the day of its adoption pursuant to Section 17 of the Charter.
