AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER II, ARTICLE 3, DIVISION 11 OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY REPEALING SUBSECTION (1)(d) OF SECTION 23.1104 [SUBSECTION (1)(d) OF SECTION 4, RULE X OF THE RULES OF THE CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION] RELATING TO SICK LEAVE REIMBURSEMENT AND MAKING PROVISION IN THE ANNUAL SALARY ORDINANCE FOR ESTABLISHING A SICK LEAVE REIMBURSEMENT PROGRAM FOR ALL ELIGIBLE EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO.

WHEREAS, the Council of The City of San Diego, by Ordinance No. 10427 (New Series) dated October 6, 1970, amended Section 23.1104 of the San Diego Municipal Code and Rule X, Section 4 of the Rules of the Civil Service Commission to provide for a program of reimbursement for unused sick leave credits upon cessation of employment; and

WHEREAS, by such action, the program was fixed within the Rules of the Civil Service Commission and the San Diego Municipal Code even though it was a fiscal impact item originating in a Memorandum of Understanding; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed desirable to delete said program from the Rules of the Civil Service Commission and reestablish said program independent thereof for employees presently enjoying said benefits; and

WHEREAS, the Civil Service Commission, on September 6, 1974, approved the deletion of said program from its rules and has recommended such amendment to the Council for appropriate action;
NOW, THEREFORE,

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
BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego,
as follows:

Section 1. That subsection (1)(d) of Section 23.1104, Chapter II, Article 3, Division 11 of the San Diego Municipal Code and subsection (1)(d) of Section 4, Rule X of the Rules of the Civil Service Commission be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section 2. There shall be incorporated by the City Council within the annual salary ordinance appropriate enabling provision for the establishment of a sick leave reimbursement program for all employees of The City of San Diego currently eligible for such reimbursement under existing provisions and for those employees hired prior to July 1, 1975.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
