AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER II, ARTICLE 7,  
DIVISION 21 OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE  
BY AMENDING SECTION 27.2119 BY PROVIDING FOR  
DEFERMENT AND ULTIMATE WAIVER OF THE \$100  
NOMINATION FEE UPON FILING OF A STATEMENT  
OF INDIGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego,  
as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter II, Article 7, Division 21 of  
the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended  
by amending Section 27.2119 to read as follows:

SEC. 27.2119 NOMINATING FEE--STATEMENT OF INDIGENCY

(a) The election nominating fee shall be  
one hundred dollars (\$100).

(b) Payment of the fee set forth in (a) above  
shall be deferred in any case where a person  
seeking nomination claims indigency and signs an  
affidavit certifying under oath or under penalty  
of perjury to the following:

- (1) Candidate's name and address.
- (2) Name and address of all dependents.
- (3) Names and addresses of employers  
during past twelve (12) months and monthly  
salary.
- (4) Description of any other source of  
income.
- (5) Total income of past twelve (12) months.

(6) Name and address of any bank where a checking or savings account is maintained and the current balances of all accounts.

(7) Total amount of cash on hand.

(8) List by address or legal description of all real property in which an interest is owned and the value of that interest.

(9) List and value of personal property owned.

(10) List of all current monthly expenses.

(11) List of outstanding debts and current balance of each.

(12) Statement that the person seeking nomination is indigent and desires therefore to defer payment of the filing fee and agrees the fee shall be paid out of campaign contributions received by the candidate or any campaign committee supporting the candidate if such contributions are in excess of three thousand dollars (\$3,000).

The indigent candidate shall pay to The City of San Diego out of contributions received by the candidate or any committee supporting the candidate the amount of the above fee or a portion thereof if such contributions are in excess of three thousand dollars (\$3,000). In the event the indigent candidate



be waived.

Section 2. Pursuant to Section 17 of the Charter of The  
City of San Diego, this ordinance, as one relating to elections,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:  
Section 1. That Chapter II, Article 7, Division 21 of the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by amending Section 27.2119 read as follows:

SEC. 27.2119. NOMINATING FEE - STATEMENT OF INDIGENCY.

(a) The election nominating fee shall be one hundred dollars (\$100).

- (9) List and value of personal property owned.
- (10) List of all current monthly expenses.
- (11) List of outstanding debts and current balance of each.
- (12) Statement that the person seeking nomination is indigent and desires therefore to defer payment of the filing fee and agrees the fee shall be paid out of campaign contributions received by the candidate or any campaign committee supporting the candidate if such contributions are in excess of three thousand dollars (\$3,000).
