AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO, CALIFORNIA, ORDERING, CALLING, PROVIDING FOR AND GIVING NOTICE OF A SPECIAL ELECTION TO BE HELD IN THE CITY ON SEPTEMBER 16, 1975, FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING TO THE QUALIFIED VOTERS OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO A PROPOSITION AMENDING THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO TO AMEND SECTION 219 TO THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO, AND CONSOLIDATING SAID SPECIAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION WITH THE MUNICIPAL PRIMARY ELECTION TO BE HELD IN SAID CITY ON SEPTEMBER 16, 1975.

WHEREAS, at a meeting held on JUL 9 1975, the City Council of The City of San Diego called a municipal primary election in the City and in the San Diego Unified School District to be held on September 16, 1975; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego desires to consolidate the two elections; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. A special municipal election is hereby called and ordered to be held in the City of San Diego, California, on September 16, 1975; and pursuant to the provisions of Section 223 of the Charter of The City of San Diego, the provisions of Section 3 of Article 11 of the Constitution of the State of California, and the provisions of Sections 34450 and 34459 of the California Government Code, the Council of The City of San Diego being the legislative body thereof, hereby proposes and submits to the qualified voters of the City at such special municipal election the following proposition amending the Charter of The City of San Diego:

PROPOSITION _____

Amend Section 219 of Article XIV of the Charter of The City of San Diego to read as follows:

Section 219. PUEBLO LANDS.

No sale of Pueblo Lands owned by The City of San Diego which are situated North of the North line of the San Diego River shall ever be valid and binding upon said City unless such sale shall have been first authorized by an ordinance duly passed by the Council and thereafter ratified by the electors of The City of San Diego at any special or general municipal election. The City Manager shall have authority to lease Pueblo Lands, provided that any lease for a term exceeding one year shall not be valid unless first authorized by ordinance of the Council. No lease shall be valid for a period of time exceeding fifty-five years.

Section 2. This proposition shall be presented and printed upon the ballot and submitted to the voters in the manner and form set out in Section 4 of this ordinance.

Section 3. The polls for this special municipal election shall be open at 7 a.m. (local time) on September 16, 1975, and shall remain open continuously until 8 p.m. (local time) on the same day at which time the polls shall be closed, except as provided in Section 14436 of the Elections Code of the State of California.

Section 4. Since this election is being consolidated with the municipal primary election; and since the City Clerk of The City of San Diego is hereby authorized to canvass returns of

this election; and since only one form of ballot is authorized, the method of voting upon this proposition shall be as provided in the Elections Code of the State of California; and, on the ballots to be used at this special municipal election, in addition to any other matters required by law, there shall be printed substantially the following:

Section 5. The special municipal election called for September 16, 1975, in the City of San Diego is hereby ordered consolidated with the municipal primary election to be held on the same date. Within the City of San Diego the precincts, polling places and officers of the election for the special municipal election shall be the same as those provided for in the municipal primary election.

Section 6. The City Clerk of The City of San Diego is hereby authorized to canvass the returns of the special municipal election and these elections shall be held in all respects as if there were only one election, and within the City only one form of ballot shall be used. The City Clerk shall certify the results of the

canvass of the returns of this special municipal election to the Council of The City of San Diego which shall then declare the results of the election.


Section 7. The proposition submitted by this ordinance shall be designated on the ballot by a letter printed on the left margin of the square containing the description of the measure as provided in Section 10231 of the Elections Code of the State of California.

Section 8. Except as otherwise provided in this ordinance, the special municipal election shall be conducted as provided by law for other municipal elections of the City.

Section 9. The City Clerk shall cause this ordinance to be published once in the official newspaper not less than 40 nor more than 60 days before the date of the election. No other notice of the election need be given.

Section 10. This ordinance shall take effect on JUL 17 1975
