

ORDINANCE NO. 11677
(New Series)

SEP 17 1975

AN ORDINANCE INCORPORATING PORTIONS OF LOTS 21, 22 AND 27, THE HIGHLANDS, IN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO, CALIFORNIA, INTO CA, M-1A AND M-1B ZONES, AS DEFINED BY SECTIONS 101.0428.1, 101.0436 AND 101.0435.2, RESPECTIVELY, OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 5890 (NEW SERIES), ADOPTED DECEMBER 15, 1953, OF THE ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO INSOFAR AS THE SAME CONFLICTS HEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That in the event that within two years of the effective date of this ordinance, portions of Lots 21, 22 and 27, The Highlands, in the City of San Diego, California, within the boundaries of the districts designated "CA," "M-1A" and "M-1B" on Zone Map Drawing No. B-2862.2, are subdivided and a final subdivision map or maps thereof duly approved by the City Council and thereafter recorded, and within such subdivision or subdivisions, provision is made for the installation of public utility services and the dedication of streets, alleys and easements for public use, the provisions of Sections 101.0428.1, 101.0436 and 101.0435.2 of the San Diego Municipal Code shall attach and become applicable to the said subdivided land and the said subdivided land shall be incorporated into CA, M-1A and M-1B Zones, as described and defined by Sections 101.0428.1, 101.0436 and 101.0435.2, respectively, the boundaries of such zones to be as indicated on Zone Map Drawing No. B-2862.2, filed in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. 752712. Said zoning shall attach only to those areas included in the subdivision map or maps recorded as provided by this section.



Section 2. That in the event the zoning restrictions shall attach to the said land described in Section 1 of this ordinance, Ordinance No. 5890 (New Series), adopted December 15, 1953, of the Ordinances of The City of San Diego, be, and the same is hereby repealed insofar as the same conflicts herewith.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
