AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER II, ARTICLE 6
OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY ADDING
SECTION 26.34 ESTABLISHING A TRANSPORTATION
ADVISORY BOARD

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego,
as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter II, Article 6 of the San Diego
Municipal Code be amended by adding Section 26.34 to read as
follows:

SEC. 26.34 TRANSPORTATION ADVISORY BOARD.

a. PURPOSE AND INTENT. It is the purpose
and intent of the City Council to establish a
Transportation Advisory Board to provide The City
of San Diego the benefit of advice of interested
citizens representative of the community in matters
relating to the implementation and operation of
transportation functions which are the responsi-
bility of the City Manager.

b. TRANSPORTATION ADVISORY BOARD. There is
hereby created a Transportation Advisory Board which
shall consist of thirteen (13) members, with one
resident-voter from each of the eight councilmanic
districts and a resident-voter from any part of the
City, who shall serve without compensation. The
members shall be appointed by the Mayor and con-
firmed by the Council. The Mayor shall make his

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appointment from each respective councilmanic district from a list of three (3) nominees submitted by the respective Councilman from that district. The five (5) additional appointments shall be made by the Mayor to any resident-voter within the City; provided, however, that four (4) of said appointments shall be made by appointing one (1) senior citizen (a person 60 years of age or over), one (1) physically handicapped person, one (1) business person whose business is served by public transportation, and one (1) person who uses public transportation as a primary mode of transportation. A member of the Board of Directors of San Diego Transit Corporation shall be appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the Council. The members shall serve two (2) year terms and each member shall serve until his or her successor is duly appointed and qualified. The members shall be appointed in such a manner that the terms of not more than seven (7) members shall expire in any year. The expiration date of all terms shall be January 1. During January of each year the Mayor may designate one (1) member as Chairman; however, in the absence of such designation, the Board shall, on or after February 15, select from among its members a Chairman. The Director of the Department

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of Transportation shall serve as Secretary to the Board. The Board shall adopt rules consistent with laws for the government of its business and procedures.

c. FUNCTIONS. The Transportation Advisory Board shall consider policy matters relating to the implementation and operation of transportation functions under the City Manager such as Dial-a-Ride, general aviation airports, street maintenance and construction, traffic and pedestrian safety, and bike paths in the City of San Diego and shall be advisory to the City Manager and through the City Manager to the City Council on these matters or others as the Council may direct. The Board shall not, under any circumstances or conditions, infringe upon the duties and responsibilities of the San Diego Transit Corporation as set forth in the operating agreement between the Corporation and The City of San Diego.

d. COMMITTEES. The Chairman, with the advice of the Board, shall appoint standing and ad hoc committees concerned with specific problems or areas of interest to the Board. The committees shall be composed of Board members, augmented by



other representative citizens appointed by the Board Chairman. The Board Chairman shall appoint Board members as Chairman and Vice Chairman of each such committee.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.


