AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER X, ARTICLE 1,  
OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY ADDING  
SECTION 101.0210 RELATING TO LIMITATION ON  
TIME FOR ACTION ATTACKING ADMINISTRATIVE  
DETERMINATION.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as  
follows:

Section 1. That Chapter X, Article 1 of the San Diego  
Municipal Code be and it is hereby amended by adding Section  
101.0210 to read as follows:

SEC. 101.0210 LIMITATION ON TIME FOR ACTION ATTACKING  
ADMINISTRATIVE DETERMINATION

Any action or proceeding to attack, review, set  
aside, void or annul any decision on a variance,  
Conditional Use Permit or Planned Residential  
Development pursuant to San Diego Municipal Code,  
Chapter X, Article 1, Divisions 5 and 9, or concerning  
any of the proceedings, acts or determinations taken,  
done or made prior to such decision, or to determine  
the reasonableness, legality or validity of any  
condition attached thereto, shall not be maintained by  
any person unless such action or proceeding is commenced  
within 180 days after the date such decision becomes  
final. Thereafter all persons are barred from any such  
action or proceeding or any defense or invalidity or  
unreasonableness of such decision or of such proceedings,  
acts or determinations.



Section 1. That Chapter X, Article 1 of the San Diego Municipal Code be and is hereby amended by adding Section 101.0210 to read as follows:

SEC. 101.0210 LIMITATION ON TIME FOR ACTION ATTACKING ADMINISTRATIVE DETERMINATION

Any action or proceeding to attack, review, set aside, void or annul any decision on a variance, Conditional Use Permit or Planned Residential Development pursuant to San Diego Municipal Code, Chapter X, Article 1, Divisions 5 and 9, or concerning any of the proceedings, acts or determinations taken, done or made prior to such decision, or to determine the reasonableness, legality or validity of any condition attached thereto, shall not be maintained by any person unless such action or proceeding is commenced within 180 days after the date such decision becomes final. Thereafter all persons are barred from any such action or proceeding or any defense or invalidity or unreasonableness of such decision or of such proceedings, acts or determinations.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
