AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER II, ARTICLE 6 OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY ADDING SECTION 26.16 ESTABLISHING A CITIZENS ADVISORY BOARD FOR AFFIRMATIVE ACTION.

WHEREAS, the Council of The City of San Diego, by Resolution No. 204843, as amended, adopted a program for affirmative action in municipal employment; and

WHEREAS, the program as adopted and amended provides for the establishment of a citizens advisory group to monitor and evaluate the program and make recommendations thereupon; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable to establish such body as a permanent advisory board pursuant to Section 43(a) of the Charter of The City of San Diego so as to accommodate continuing fixed terms of appointment for members thereof; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter II, Article 6 of the San Diego Municipal Code be amended by adding Section 26.16 to read as follows:

SEC. 26.16 CITIZENS ADVISORY BOARD FOR AFFIRMATIVE ACTION

A. PURPOSE AND INTENT.

It is the purpose and intent of the City Council to establish a Citizens Advisory Board for

Affirmative Action to advise on a continuing basis the Mayor, City Council, Manager and other agencies of City government of the progress being made in the Affirmative Action Program adopted by the Council.

B. CITIZENS ADVISORY BOARD ESTABLISHED.

There is hereby established a Citizens Advisory Board for Affirmative Action which shall consist of nine (9) members who shall serve without compensation. The Board shall include one (1) representative from each of the following minority groups: Mexican-American, Black, Filipino, American Indian and Asian/Oriental. The remaining four (4) members shall be appointed from the City at large. The members shall be appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the Council. The members shall serve two (2) year terms and each member shall serve until his successor is duly appointed and qualified. The members shall be appointed in such manner that the terms of not more than five (5) members shall expire in any year. The expiration date of all terms shall be January 1. During January of each year the Mayor may designate one (1) member as Chairman; however, in the absence of such designation, the Board shall on or after February 15 select a Chairman from among its members. Any vacancy shall be filled for

the unexpired term of the member whose place becomes vacant. The Board shall adopt such rules, regulations and organizational structure for the conduct of its business as it may deem necessary.

C. DUTIES AND FUNCTIONS.

The Board shall:


1. Monitor and/or evaluate the Affirmative Action Program of the City as it exists and as it may be amended from time to time by the City Council.

2. Advise on a continuing basis and make recommendations regarding the Program as are deemed necessary to the Mayor, City Council, Manager and other agencies and appropriate authority of City government.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter II, Article 6 of the San Diego Municipal Code be amended by adding Section 26.16 to read as follows:

SEC. 26.16 CITIZENS ADVISORY BOARD FOR AFFIRMATIVE ACTION

C. DUTIES AND FUNCTIONS.

The Board Shall:

1. Monitor and/or evaluate the Affirmative Action Program of the City as it exists and as it may be amended from time to time by the City Council.

2. Advise on a continuing basis and make recommendations regarding the Program as are deemed necessary to the Mayor, City Council, Manager and other agencies and appropriate authority of City Government.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.


