AN ORDINANCE DEDICATING CERTAIN PORTIONS OF PUEBLO LANDS IN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO, CALIFORNIA, FOR A PUBLIC PARK AND NAMING SAID PARK "COLLIER PARK WEST."

WHEREAS, The City of San Diego is the owner of certain Pueblo Lands in The City of San Diego; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the people of The City of San Diego to dedicate forever portions of said Pueblo Lands, hereinafter described, for public use and enjoyment as and for a public park to be used by all the public for park and recreational purposes; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That the hereinafter described real property be and the same is hereby dedicated in perpetuity as a public park to be used by all the public for park and recreational purposes.

Section 2. That the hereinafter described real property be and the same is hereby named "Collier Park West."

Section 3. That the real property so dedicated and named is described in Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated herein.

Section 4. That the City Clerk of said City be and he is hereby authorized and directed to file for record in the office of the Recorder of San Diego County a certified copy of this ordinance.



LEGAL DESCRIPTION

(Collier Park)

That portion of Pueblo Lot 206 of the Pueblo Lands of San Diego (formerly known as Collier Park) in the City of San Diego, County of San Diego, State of California, according to Map thereof made by James Pascoe in 1870 a copy of which said Map was filed in the office of the County Recorder of said San Diego County November 14, 1921 and is known as Miscellaneous Map No. 36, being more particularly described as follows:

That portion of said Pueblo Lot 206 lying Westerly of the Westerly line of the 200.00 foot right of way of Nimitz Boulevard (formerly Wabaska Drive) as now located and established, and lying Southeasterly of the Southeasterly line of Soto Street as now located and established and lying Northeasterly of the Northeasterly line of Loma Alta No. 1 according to Map thereof No. 1078 filed in the office of the County Recorder of said San Diego County.

EXCEPTING therefrom that portion thereof described as follows:

Beginning at the most Northerly corner of Block 11 of said Map No. 1078; thence Northeasterly along the Northeasterly prolongation of the Northwestern line of said Block 11 to a line which is parallel with and 250.00 feet Northeasterly of and measured at right angles to the Northeasterly line of said Map No. 1078; thence Northwesterly along said parallel line to a line which is parallel with and 192.00 feet Southeasterly of and measured at right angles to the Southeasterly line of J. M. De Puy's Subdivision of the West Half of the Northwest Quarter of said Pueblo Lot 206 according to Map thereof No. 30 filed in the office of the County Recorder of said San Diego County; thence Southwesterly along said parallel line to a line which is parallel with and 30.00 feet Northeasterly of and measured at right angles to the Northeasterly line of said Map No. 1078; thence Northwesterly along said parallel line to the Southwesterly prolongation of the Southeasterly line of said Soto Street as shown on Valeta Knolls according to Map thereof No. 3716 filed in the office
