AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 11650 (NEW SERIES), AS AMENDED, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1975-76 AND APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY MONEY TO OPERATE THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR" BY AMENDING DOCUMENT NO. 750397, AS ADOPTED AND AMENDED THEREIN, RELATING TO TRANSFER OF REVENUE SHARING FUNDS TO THE GENERAL FUND FOR THE PURCHASE OF SCALES, COMPUTER EQUIPMENT AND SOFTWARE FOR USE AT SANITARY FILLS, AND DIRECTING THE AUDITOR AND COMPTROLLER TO EFFECT THE NECESSARY MONETARY TRANSFERS AND ADJUSTMENTS.

WHEREAS, the fiscal year 1976 budget includes \$153,000 of General Revenue Sharing Funds in the Capital Improvements Program for the purpose of scales, computer equipment and software for use at sanitary landfills; and

WHEREAS, upon review by the Public Facilities and Recreation Committee, it was recommended that General Funds should be used in lieu of General Revenue Sharing Funds; and

WHEREAS, such recommendation was approved by the City Council on November 5, 1975; and

WHEREAS, it is now necessary to transfer the said General Revenue Sharing Funds to the Solid Waste Division operating budget in order to make available to finance the project the sum of \$153,000 in the General Fund; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 11650 (New Series), as amended, entitled "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1975-76 AND APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY MONEY TO OPERATE THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR," be and the same is hereby further amended by amending Document No. 750397, as adopted and amended therein, relating to the transfer of Revenue Sharing Funds to the General Fund by transferring the sum of \$153,000 (General Revenue Sharing Funds--Fund 2385) from Capital Improvements Project No. 37-055 (Solid Waste Processing, Section 2, subsection 7) to General Fund 100, Department 37.32, Solid Waste Division Non-Personal Expense (Solid Waste Processing, Section 2, subsection 7) for the sole and exclusive purpose of providing funds for scales, computer equipment and software for use at sanitary landfills.


Section 2. That Capital Improvements Project No. 37-055, Solid Waste Processing, be and the same is hereby deleted.

Section 3. That the Auditor and Comptroller be and he is hereby fully authorized and directed to effect the necessary monetary transfer and adjustment to accomplish the action set forth in Section 1 above.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.


