1. That the City Manager be and he is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with the SWEETWATER UNION HIGH SCHOOL DISTRICT for the improvement of Iris Street for a distance of approximately 1,000 feet, pursuant to the terms and conditions set forth in the form of agreement on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. 749836.

2. That the expenditure of a sum not to exceed \$29,323 be and it is hereby authorized out of Gas Tax Fund 219 of The City of San Diego, solely and exclusively for the purpose of effecting the improvement of Iris Street as described hereinabove.
