Said Committee shall be formed and operate in conformance with the provisions of Section 26.30(d) of the San Diego Municipal Code.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Manager be, and he is hereby authorized to assign qualified staff support to said Committee as the need arises.
