
BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego as follows:

R75-1483

1. That the bids of A. SESCO, B. Econolite, C. Multisonics, Inc., D. United Signal, Inc. are hereby accepted and the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute contracts for the purchase of FIVE (5) TRAFFIC SIGNAL CONTROLLERS as follows:
 - A. SESCO, for Item 1, one traffic signal controller for the intersection of Adams Avenue and Felton Street, for a cost of \$5,037.40, terms net 30 days plus sales tax.
 - B. Econolite, for Item 2, one traffic signal controller for the intersection of Ingraham Street and Pacific Beach Drive, for a cost of \$4,250.50, terms net 30 days plus sales tax.
 - C. Multisonics, Inc. for Items 3 and 5, one traffic signal controller for the intersection of Dana Basin Road/Quivera Basin Road and W. Mission Bay Drive; and one traffic signal controller for the intersection of Clairemont Mesa Boulevard and Ruffner Street, for a cost of \$17,500.00, terms net 30 days plus sales tax.
 - D. United Signal, Inc. for Item 4, one traffic signal controller for the intersection of Mission Boulevard and West Mission Bay Drive, for a cost of \$6,222.00, terms net 30 days plus sales tax.
2. That the expenditure of \$35,100.00 is hereby authorized from Gas Tax Funds (Fund No.220) of the City of San Diego solely and exclusively for the purpose of providing funds for the purchase of FIVE (5) TRAFFIC SIGNAL CONTROLLERS and related costs.
