BACKGROUND

Parking Meters are designed to provide maximum utilization of premium on-street parking spaces. In fact, in three or four major commercial areas, most parking meters installed in San Diego have been initiated by one or more adjacent property owners and/or occupants. In determining the extent of meter installations in any area, parking space usage and traffic flow factors are considered. Requests for large scale meter removals were first received in late 1959 and similar technical factors were considered in acting upon these requests.

Parking Meters are devices which allot parking time to motorists for a fee as determined by City ordinance. Parking meters are employed in areas where street parking is in short supply and are being monopolized by long-term parkers. Parking meters are designed to insure maximum utilization of premium street parking spaces.

PURPOSE

To formalize criteria used in parking meter installations and removals, and to assure complete and equitable treatment of all requests for such installations and removals.

POLICY

It is the policy of the Council to consider the following criteria when installing or removing parking meters:

- (a) Existing use of curb parking;
- (b) Traffic volume and patterns;
- (c) Enforcement problems relative to contiguity or isolation from other parking meter areas;
- (d) Area affected--whether an entire block or portion of a block;
- (e) Time limits to be used or to remain after meter removal;
- (f) Desires of adjacent property owners.

A survey for criteria data may be made upon the Council's initiative, the City Manager's initiative, or upon receipt of a petition representing at least sixty per cent (60%) of all adjacent property owners affected, and the results of such survey are furnished to the Council by report of the City Manager.

A survey for criteria data may be made upon the Council's initiative, the City Manager's initiative, or upon receipt of a petition representing at least sixty per cent (60%) of all adjacent property owners affected. The City Manager will report the results of such survey to the Council at the time installation or removal of parking meters is considered.
