Parking Meters are devices which allot parking time to motorists for a fee as determined by City ordinance. Parking meters are employed in areas where street parking is in short supply and are being monopolized by long-term parkers. Parking meters are designed to insure maximum utilization of premium street parking spaces.

PURPOSE

To formalize criteria used in parking meter installations and removals, and to assure complete and equitable treatment of all requests for such installations and removals.

POTTCY

It is the policy of the Council to consider the following criteria when installing or removing parking meters:

- (a) Existing use of curb parking; .
- (b) Traffic volume and patterns;
- (c) Enforcement problems relative to contiguity or isolation from other parking meter areas;
- (d) Area affected--whether an entire block or portion of a block;
- (e) Time limits to be used or to remain after meter removel;
- (f) Desires of adjacent property owners.

Arounvey- for criteria that may be made upon the Council's initiative; the fifty-kaneger's initiative; or upon receipt of a specifican representing at least sixty per cent (60%) of all-unjacent sproperty owners affected; and the receives of such oursey are furnished to the Gouncil-by-report of the fity-kengers

A survey for criteria data may be made upon the Council's initiative, the city Manager's initiative, or upon receipt of a petition representing at least sixty per cent (60%) of all adjacent property owners affected.
