WHEREAS, nonpartisanship has been the character of the elections of the City of San Diego since as long ago as 1925; and

WHEREAS, the injection of partisan politics into local elections is proposed by Assembly Bill No. 330; and

WHEREAS, said A.B. 330 in its present form will become operative only if a companion constitutional amendment is approved by the electorate of the State; and

WHEREAS, the Council of The City of San Diego believes that the abandonment of nonpartisan local elections is unwise and that the benefits of nonpartisan local elections are many and should be continued; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego that the Council opposes the enactment of A.B. 330 amending Section 41 of the Elections Code to change the status of local county and municipal elected offices from nonpartisan to partisan and urges the State Legislature to reject the same.
