## COUNCIL POLICY SUBJECT ZONING APPLICATIONS, REFILING G00-13 COUNCIL POLICY PAGE 1 of 1

## BACKGROUND .

Section 101.0205, San Diego Municipal Code, provides in part as follows:

"...No application from one or more owners of property, for zoning or resoning the same property or essentially the same parcel of land, which has been denied by the City Council, shall be accepted by the Planning Commission within twelve months of such denial; provided, however, that the City Council may permit the processing of such application by the affirmative vote of the majority of its members."

The above quoted section was adopted by the City Council on December 8, 1953, amended November 10, 1966, in order to maintain the peace and tranquility of the affected community, avoid duplicative and unnecessary hearings and promote finality of decisions of Council determiniations.

## PURPOSE ....

The purpose of this policy is to establish criteria to be used by the Council in determining whether or not a second application within twelve months after the first application for rezoning should be approved: In order to accomplish the intent of Section 101.0205 of the San Diego Municipal Code, permission to reapply within a twelve month period should be granted only under extraordinary circumstances.

## POLICY

The That Council may approve an application for refiling within a twelve month period only upon finding that one or more of the following criteria can be met:

- .1. A substantial change in the zoning or land use pattern in the area has taken place subsequent to the previous denial to rezone the preperty.
- 2. Regulations, plans or formal policies of the City or a governmental agency have been modified after the original application in a manner which could significantly affect the use of the applicant's property or the land surrounding the applicant's property.
- The new application requests zoning or zoning boundaries that could not be considered at the original hearing because of the legal requirements of the Municipal Code. (Sections 101.0206 and through 101.0208)
- 4. Any of there are other unusual or extraordinary circumstances not known at the time of the original hearing which in the judgment of the Council would merit a new application to be filed pursuant to Section 101.0205.
