A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING AN UNDERGROUND UTILITY DISTRICT TO BE KNOWN AND DENOMINATED AS THE WEST POINT LOMA BOULEVARD, LOMA RIVIERA DRIVE TO MIDWAY DRIVE, UNDERGROUND UTILITY DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 212427, a public hearing was called for on FEB 20 1975 at the hour of 8:30 a.m. in the Council Chambers of the City Administration Building, 202 C Street, San Diego, California, to determine whether the public health, safety or general welfare requires the removal of poles, overhead wires and associated overhead structures and the underground installation of wires and facilities for supplying electric, communication, community antenna television or similar or associated service within that certain area of the City of San Diego more particularly described as follows:

The portions of PUEBLO LOT 219, MAP 841 as shown on City of San Diego Drawing No. 16351-D; Lots 44, 45, 47 of BAY CREST, MAP 5334; Lot 1, of PALISADES PLAZA, MAP 5199; Lot 1 of H & H SUBDIVISION, MAP 4225.

Said district shall also include the following described public right of way:

WEST POINT LOMA BOULEVARD between the westerly line of Loma Riviera Drive and Midway Drive; SPORTS ARENA BOULEVARD between the northerly line of Ollie Street and a line 200 feet westerly of the westerly line of Hancock Street; MIDWAY DRIVE between West Point Loma Boulevard and a line 200 feet northerly of the northerly line of Map 5438; CHAPMAN STREET between West Point Loma Boulevard and the southerly line of Lot 1, H & H Subdivision, Map 4225; GROTON STREET between

West Point Loma Boulevard and a line 150 feet southerly of West Point Loma Boulevard; CHANNEL WAY between Sports Arena Boulevard and a line 50 feet northeasterly of Sports Arena Boulevard; OLLIE STREET between Sports Arena Boulevard and the southwesterly line of Lot 22, Drucker's Subdivision, Map 1584.

and all as more particularly shown on Drawing No. 16351-D, entitled "WEST POINT LOMA BOULEVARD (Loma Riviera to Midway Drive) UNDERGROUND UTILITY DISTRICT," copies of which are on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. 749952 and attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, notice of such hearing has been given by the City Clerk to all affected property owners as defined in Chapter VI, Article 1, Division 5 of the San Diego Municipal Code, and the utilities concerned in the manner and for the time required by law; and

WHEREAS, such hearing has been duly and regularly held and all persons interested have been given an opportunity to be heard; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

1. The City Council does hereby find and determine that the public health, safety and general welfare require the removal of poles, overhead wires and associated overhead structures and the underground installation of wires and facilities for supplying electric, communication, community antenna television or similar or associated service within the area set forth above

and that pursuant to Chapter VI, Article 1, Division 5 of the San Diego Municipal Code, the above-described area is hereby declared to be an underground utility district in the City of San Diego, and the maps and document referred to above are hereby incorporated as a part of this resolution.

- 2. The City Council shall by subsequent resolution fix the date upon which the property in the district must be ready to receive underground service, and shall by subsequent resolution order the removal of all poles, overhead wires and associated overhead structures and the underground installation of wires and facilities for supplying electric, communication, community antenna television or similar or associated service.
- 3. The City Clerk be and he is hereby instructed to notify all affected persons as defined in Chapter VI, Article 1, Division 5 of the San Diego Municipal Code, and all affected utility companies of the adoption of this resolution within fifteen (15) days after the date of such adoption. The City Clerk shall further notify said affected persons as defined in Chapter VI, Article 1, Division 5 of the San Diego Municipal Code of the necessity that if they desire to continue to receive electric, communication, community antenna television or similar or associated service, they shall provide at their own expense all necessary facility changes on their premises so as to receive underground service from the lines relocated underground of the

supplying utility company subject to applicable rules, regulations and tariffs of the respective utility company on file with the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California (as of the date of adoption of this resolution) and subject to all other applicable requirements of State law and City ordinances. The Clerk's notification shall be made in the manner provided in Chapter VI, Article 1, Division 5 of the San Diego Municipal Code.

4. The City Council hereby finds that the underground utility district created herein is required by the public health, safety and general welfare for the following reason:

This street is extensively used by the general public and carries a heavy volume of pedestrian and vehicular traffic.
