That the expenditure of \$1,600 from Capital Outlay Fund 245 of The City of San Diego is hereby authorized solely and exclusively for the purpose of providing funds for installation of an ornamental electrolier on Carleton Street adjacent to the City-owned pump station.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Manager be, and he is hereby authorized and empowered to do by City Forces all necessary work in conjunction with the above referenced project of installing an ornamental electrolier, pursuant to the recommendation of the City Manager and the submission of his estimates indicating that said work can be done more economically by City Forces than if let by contract.
