as follows:

That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to solicit proposals for an engineering study of the structural integrity of the Ford Building in Balboa Park.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the expenditure of not to exceed ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00) from Transient Occupancy Tax Fund 224 is hereby authorized solely and exclusively to provide funds for the above stated purpose.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that if the engineering study indicates that the Ford Building is suitable for public occupancy, that the City Manager is directed to provide alternative sites for the storage of Park and Recreation Department supplies which presently are stored in the basement of the Ford Building.
