WHEREAS, the Council of The City of San Diego requested the Transportation and Land Use Committee of said Council to consider the matter of the establishment of cable television (CATV) rates throughout the City; and

WHEREAS, the Transportation and Land Use Committee has prepared two reports dated February 7, 1975 and February 24, 1975, respectively, copies of which have been filed with the City Clerk as Documents Nos. 750642 and 750643; and

WHEREAS, the City Clerk has caused to be served copies of said reports upon all parties to the proceedings; and

WHEREAS, all exceptions and replies to exceptions to the Report have been duly and fully considered by this City Council;
NOW, THEREFORE,


BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

That this Council hereby approves and adopts the maximum City-wide CATV rates and charges (excluding Rancho Bernardo) recommended in the February 7, 1975 and February 24, 1975 reports of the Transportation and Land Use Committee which are on file in the office of the City Clerk as Documents Nos. 750642 and 750643, respectively, and finds and concludes that the maximum rates and charges set forth in said reports are just and reasonable.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that CATV operators must file an advisory letter with the City and notify their customers 30 days prior to changing any rates or charges up to and including the maximums stated in Documents Nos. 750642 and 750643.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that for any proposed rate or charge increase above the maximums stated in Documents Nos. 750642 and 750643 the operator must make application for a rate hearing in accordance with the City's adopted "Rules and Procedures Governing Cable Television Rate Applications."
