BACKGROUND

Under the provisions of the San Diego Municipal Code, The City of San Diego is authorized to regulate the construction and operation of billboards adjacent to landscaped freeways as defined in Section 95.0302.2 and scenic freeways, scenic highways and parkways which the Council has declared, after public hearing, to be subject to such regulation.

PURPOSE

To establish the frequency with which the City Council will hold public hearings for the purpose of designating such scenic freeways, highways and parkways.

POLICY

The City Council may hold public hearings on the definition of scenic free-ways, scenic highways and parkways so as to regulate the construction and operation of billboards adjacent thereto. It shall be the policy of the City Council to hold said hearings at such times as the Council by the affirmative vote of a majority of its total authorized voting members deems it to be in the interest of the City to preserve and protect areas adjacent to said freeways, highways, and parkways which have scenic or landscaped vistas or are possessed of historical significance.
