WHEREAS, one General Electric main sewage pump motor with capacity of 5000 volts and 2250 horsepower, and located at City Pump Station Number 2 on North Harbor Drive, has broken down and is in immediate need of repair; and

WHEREAS, said motor is one of four at the pump station, said motors consisting of three main motors and one standby motor; and

WHEREAS, three motors are required to pump raw sewage to the Point Loma sewage treatment facilities and at this time there are two main motors in operation and one standby motor in operation without an operative fourth motor to be used as a standby in case one of said three motors breaks down; and

WHEREAS, if one of the three motors became inoperative without the availability of a fourth operative standby motor, there is the possibility of raw sewage flowing into San Diego Bay; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

That because an emergency repair situation exists, and because the public interest demands the immediate expenditure of public money without advertising for bids in order to safeguard public health and property from the threat of raw sewage flowing into San Diego Bay, and pursuant to the Charter of The City of San Diego, Section 94, the necessary repair

contract shall be awarded to Arnhart Electric Co., which quoted the lowest contract price of the three firms contacted by the Purchasing Department, said contract amount not to exceed \$7,932.00, and the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute said contract subject to the City Attorney's approving the contract as to form and legality prior to its execution by the Manager.
