A RESOLUTION DETERMINING AND DECLARING THAT THE PUBLIC INTEREST, CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO REQUIRE THE CONSTRUCTION, OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF A FIRE STATION IN LOT 1 OF MINUTE MANOR, ACCORDING TO MAP THEREOF NO. 3569, IN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO, COUNTY OF SAN DIEGO, STATE OF CALIFORNIA; AND THAT THE PUBLIC INTEREST, CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY DEMAND THE ACQUISITION OF FEE TITLE TO SAID PROPERTY FOR SAID FIRE STATION; AND DECLARING THE INTENTION OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO TO ACQUIRE SAID PROPERTY UNDER EMINENT DOMAIN PROCEEDINGS; AND DIRECTING THE CITY ATTORNEY OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO TO COMMENCE AN ACTION IN THE SUPERIOR COURT OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA, IN AND FOR THE COUNTY OF SAN DIEGO, FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONDEMNING AND ACQUIRING SAID PROPERTY.


BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That the public interest, convenience and necessity of The City of San Diego, and the inhabitants thereof, require the construction, operation and maintenance of a fire station in Lot 1 of Minute Manor, according to Map thereof No. 3569, as more particularly described hereinafter.

Section 2. That the public interest, convenience and necessity of said City, and the inhabitants thereof, demand the acquisition and taking of fee title to said property for the construction, operation and maintenance of a fire station, said real property lying within the City of San Diego, County of San Diego, State of California.

Section 3. That the parcel of real property sought to be condemned is described as follows:

Lot 1 of Minute Manor, in the City of San Diego, County of San Diego, State of California, according to Map thereof No. 3569, filed in the Office of the County Recorder of San Diego County, December 21, 1956.



Section 4. That the taking and acquiring by said City of the real property hereinabove described is deemed necessary for the construction, operation and maintenance of a fire station by The City of San Diego and the inhabitants thereof, for municipal purposes; that such use is a public use and that for such public use it is necessary that The City of San Diego condemn and acquire said real property; that said real property is to be used for the construction, operation and maintenance of a fire station, which is planned and located in a manner most compatible with the greatest public good and the least private injury.

Section 5. That the City Attorney of The City of San Diego be, and he is hereby authorized and directed to commence an action in the Superior Court of the State of California, in and for the County of San Diego, in the name and on behalf of The City of San Diego, against all owners and claimants to an interest in the above-described real property, for the purpose of condemning and acquiring the fee interest as above-described, for the use of said City.
