RESOLUTION OF INTENTION NO. 213207

A RESOLUTION ELECTING TO PROCEED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THE STREET VACATION ACT OF 1941, DECLARING THE INTENTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL TO VACATE POPLAR STREET BETWEEN I-805 AND THE NORTHWESTERLY PROLONGATION OF THE NORTHEASTERLY LINE OF LOT 21, BLOCK 33, LEXINGTON PARK; MARIGOLD STREET BETWEEN I-805 AND AZALEA PARK; AND THE ALLEY BETWEEN LOTS 18 AND 19, BLOCK 34, LEXINGTON PARK AND FIXING A TIME AND PLACE FOR HEARING THEREOF.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that the public interest and convenience of said City requires the vacation of a portion of the streets hereinafter mentioned; and in connection therewith require the reservation of a certain easement for sewer purposes in the area covered by one of said streets.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that it is the intention of said

Council to order the vacation of POPLAR STREET between I-805 and
the northwesterly prolongation of the northeasterly line of Lot 21,

Block 33, Lexington Park; MARIGOLD STREET between I-805 and Azalea

Park; and the ALLEY between Lots 18 and 19, Block 34, Lexington

Park, as more particularly shown on Map No. 15381-D, on file in
the office of the City Clerk as Document No.

751184

The Council hereby elects to proceed, in making said vacation, under the provisions of the "Street Vacation Act of 1941."

The Council hereby fixes 8:30 a.m., JUN 5 1975 in the Council Chamber on the twelfth floor of the City Administration Building, The Charles C. Dail Concourse, 202 C Street, in said City of San Diego, as the time and place for hearing all persons interested in or objecting to the proposed vacation.

That The Daily Transcript, a daily newspaper published and circulated, and of general circulation, in the said City of San Diego, be, and it is hereby designated as the newspaper in which the Street Superintendent of said City shall cause to be published, in the manner and form required by law, notice of the passage of this Resolution of Intention, and the said Street Superintendent is hereby directed to cause notices of the passage of this resolution to be posted in the manner and form required by law and to cause a notice similar in substance to be published in said newspaper in the manner required by law.
