WHEREAS, a petition has been filed with the City Clerk under Document No. 750457 requesting the formation of Park District No. 16 of the City of San Diego pursuant to the San Diego Park District Procedural Ordinance of 1969 (commencing with Section 61.0601 of the San Diego Municipal Code); and

WHEREAS, Section 61.0615 of said Municipal Code requires a petition to be signed by the owners of at least sixty percent (60%) of the area of assessable lands in the proposed assessment district; and

WHEREAS, the above-referenced petition as filed does not bear the requisite number of qualified signers as the signers represented only forty-six percent (46%) of the area of assessable lands in the assessment district, and the Clerk of said City has certified the insufficiency of said petition to this Council; and

WHEREAS, the above-referenced petition includes signatures of seventy-two percent (72%) of the resident owners; and

WHEREAS, the aforementioned Park District Procedural Ordinance of 1969 provides an alternative method for the formation and initiation of an open space park district and permits the City Council to initiate, by its own motion, the formation of said District; and

WHEREAS, this Council now deems it desirable to initiate the formation of Park District No. 16 of the City of San Diego, commonly

known as Hendrix Park Assessment District, upon its own motion and that the public interest, convenience and necessity require said formation; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

- 1. That Park District No. 16 of The City of San Diego (Hendrix Park Assessment District) be and the same is hereby initiated pursuant to the San Diego Park District Procedural Ordinance of 1969. Further that all proceedings regarding the contemplated Park District No. 16 shall be undertaken pursuant to the terms of Division 8 of said Procedural Ordinance of 1969.
- 2. That the City Manager be and he is hereby directed to prepare plans for the acquisition, improvement and maintenance of the lands shown on Exhibit A together with the estimates of the costs and expenses of such acquisition, improvement and maintenance, to submit applicable materials to the Environmental Quality Department for appropriate review and reports of environmental impact, to prepare an estimate of the assessment to be levied upon each parcel of benefiting property within the proposed district, and to furnish this Council with a description of the district and a plat indicating the boundaries of the district to be included in the assessment for said acquisition, improvement and maintenance.
