Jack T. Argent	PARK & RECREATION DEPARTMENT	\$50	The suggestion by this Recreation Supervisor was of a particular way to prevent the constant breakage of basketball backboards. This is an initial award for a saving that is expected to amount to \$1350 per year.
John A. Clements	GENERAL SERVICES DEPARTMENT Equipment Division	\$50	This Equipment Mechanic was concerned with the number of times refuse packers break down and the air brake system becomes inoperative until time-consuming changes are made. He proposed installing fittings on the air tanks so they can be readily inflated so the trucks can be moved. This will save a net of \$494 per year in maintenance.
John A. Clements	GENERAL SERVICES DEPARTMENT	\$40	The City has a fleet of 22 new packer trucks. The location of the cab heaters is such that they are constantly being damaged when the trucks are operated in the rough terrain of City fills. It was suggested that these heaters be relocated in a certain way so their vulnerability is virtually eliminated. This will save a net of \$392 per year.
Louis Denov	TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT Communication & Electrical Div.	\$30	A new tuning procedure was devised by this Electronic Technician for "handie-talkies." This will save about \$280 per year for 160 units.
John A. Clements	GENERAL SERVICES DEPARTMENT	\$30	This suggestion was to install two lifting handles on each of two cover panels on the rear of Garwood packers. These will eliminate a dangerous and time consuming operation to remove them. The Suggestion Awards Committee felt an award of \$30 is deserved.

Jerry J. Jorgensen	GENERAL SERVICES DEPARTMENT Solid Waste Division	\$20	When the hydraulic reservoirs of Heil packers are refilled, they usually let oil run out on the street through the fill-pipes. This Crewman II suggested extensions be made to the fill-pipes to eliminate spillage. This has been done to save oil and to prevent creating an undesirable condition in City streets. The Suggestion Awards Committee felt that a \$20 award should be made.
Valdimir Kisak	PARK & RECREATION DEPARTMENT Park Division	\$20	This Recreation Facility Caretaker was concerned by the damage to four soccer goal posts. He devised a way to make them more resistant to damage. This has been done, but the goals will be replaced by a more rugged type goal that costs only a little more. It is felt that \$20 is an appropriate award for extending the life of the present goals.
