A RESOLUTION ELECTING TO PROCEED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THE STREET VACATION ACT OF 1941, DECLARING THE INTENTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL TO VACATE LAPWAI STREET SOUTHEASTERLY OF CHANNEL WAY AND FIXING A TIME AND PLACE FOR HEARING THEREOF.

That The Daily Transcript, a daily newspaper published and circulated, and of general circulation, in the said City of San Diego, be, and it is hereby designated as the newspaper in which the Street Superintendent of said City shall cause to be published, in the manner and form required by law, notice of the passage of this Resolution of Intention, and the said Street Superintendent is hereby directed to cause notices of the passage of this resolution

to be posted in the manner and form required by law and to cause a notice similar in substance to be published in said newspaper in the manner required by law.
