BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Manager be and he is hereby directed to accept and hold in abeyance the offer of LION PROPERTY COMPANY relating to an option to lease Lots 6 and 7 at Montgomery Field for the purpose of construction, operation and maintenance of a commercial and light industrial office complex under the terms and conditions contained in the form of Option to Lease Agreement on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. 751521

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Manager is authorized and directed to publicly advertise through a newspaper of general publication and communicate via direct contact with all potential developers and local broker's organizations regarding the availability of Lots 6 and 7, Montgomery Field, for lease and solicit proposals for options to lease said Lots 6 and 7, pursuant to the provisions of Council Policy 700-10.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the public solicitation for offers shall indicate that all such offers must be received on or before the fortieth day after the adoption of this resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all such potential lessors and brokers shall be informed that the City Manager will consider any proposal from a responsible bidder which provides for a return to City of at least five percent greater than the return proposed under the lease negotiated with Lion Property Company.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that such overbid information shall be available to existing and potentially interested bidders so that appropriate additional overbids may be formulated and submitted to City.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that in the event responsible overbids, as determined by the City Manager, are received in response to solicitations providing a greater return to the City as set forth hereinabove, the City Manager is directed to make recommendations thereupon to the Council for further appropriate action.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that:

1. In the event no responsible bid providing a greater return to the City as set forth hereinabove is

The City Manager be authorized and empowered to execute, for and on behalf of The City of San Diego, a Lease Agreement with LION PROPERTY COMPANY after all option terms and conditions have been performed and the option has form of been exercised, which Aease agreement is on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. 751522.
