WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego desires to study the implementation of a fixed guideway MAC Transit System in Center City as the first increment of a regional transit system; and

WHEREAS, the recommended source of funding for system implementation is funds appropriated under SCA 15; and

WHEREAS, in order to qualify for SCA 15 capital funding a grant application, financial implementation program, detailed design, performance specifications, bids and bid evaluation must be prepared; and

WHEREAS, Tudor Engineering Company and Mitchell Research Associates under contract to the City were responsible for the detailed planning of the MAC Transportation System leading to the recommendation for system implementation; and

WHEREAS, to most efficiently implement the system and complement redevelopment staff it is desirable to assign Planning Department staff to direct this effort and jointly house them with redevelopment staff;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego that the City Manager (or his authorized representative) be and is hereby authorized to accept the SCA 15 grant and execute the necessary agreements and/or contracts required for grant administration; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego that the transfer of \$155,000 from Transit Reserve Fund 2571 is authorized (after approval of the City's SCA 15 grant application) for the purpose of:

- 1. Funding a consultant contract (\$55,000) with Mitchell Research Associates for the purpose of preparing a SCA 15 capital grant application and a financial plan for implementation;
 - 2. Funding a consultant contract (\$80,000) with Tudor Engineering Company

for the purpose of beginning the preparation of a detailed design, performance specifications, seeking and evaluating bids for construction of the system;

3. Funding the establishment of a project implementation office (\$20,000) for the purpose of managing and administering program implementation and providing the necessary support (including travel, special consultant advice, and office expense) for the project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Manager (or his authorized representative) be and is hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the above mentioned consultant contracts, required leases (for office space) and agreements for special consulting support services that may be required to carry out this program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Planning Department staff are authorized to provide support (as program managers) and establish a project office to carry out the study.
