BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the amount to be reimbursed shall not exceed \$800.00.

I enjoyed the opportunity to sit down with you and Buzzie
Bavasi this morning and discuss the details of the High School BIG
Sports Night with the Padres, tentatively scheduled for June
11. As we discussed, 7-Eleven's objective in this endeavor
