is hereby determined to be feasible and that the lands to be assessed therefor will be able to carry the burden of such proposed assessment, and that the public convenience and necessity require the proposed improvement, and that the Special Assessment Investigation, Limitation and Majority Protest Act of 1931 shall not apply.
